Located in midtown Baltimore City, State Center comprises approximately twenty-eight acres around the State Center/Cultural Center Metro Station and across from the Cultural Center Light Rail Station. State Center is now the focus of a collaborative and cooperative effort between the State of Maryland and the City of Baltimore to revitalize the State's office complex and the surrounding communities through extensive redevelopment and the application of Transit Oriented Development principles.
